Athletic Leadership 10/11 Course Outline

The Athletic Leadership course was locally developed for students in grades 10 & 11. ***The course runs after school every other day 3pm - 4:30pm for the entire school year, as a linear course. Further to the scheduled times, the course also runs during athletic and school community events that are scheduled at our school, which are virtually daily and extensive in frequency.*** Certain seasons, especially basketball (winter) and spring season, feature extensive opportunities for students to become involved in their school community. Due to athletic events being scheduled outside of the regular timetable and our regular meeting time, this course can ***NOT*** be scheduled during the regular instructional day time frame and therefore must be a variance/X block. ***Students enroll in this course for the entire school year. It is not limited to one semester – as Athletics are not limited to one semester – and this must be a consideration for students who choose to take this course. Students who take this course must be highly invested and committed to bettering and providing for their school and local community.***

Athletic Leadership creates opportunities to demonstrate leadership in a “service education” role to fulfill graduating requirements. Athletic Leadership also creates strong school culture and community by hosting successful events for the entire student body that are not only critical and essential for these events and experiences to occur in the first place, but they also foster a sense of selflessness and belonging for the actual Athletic Leadership students. Often, our Athletic Leadership students are or potentially become Thunderbird athletes, as well.

Students who contribute ***at least 50 hours or more*** become eligible to receive the Chad Collingwood Memorial Award at our annual Athletic banquet; the Athletic Leadership student who contributes the most volunteer hours to their school and local community will be awarded this award.

Interested students will be required to apply online and provide a teacher reference. Interviews will be scheduled for successful applicants before being added to the course.
